IF YOU WANT TO SEE ANOTHER SIDE TO THE CITY, TRY DROPPING DOWN TO 'WHARF-LEVEL'. YOU CAN EVEN SPEND A NIGHT IN DE HOENDERVORST, A 13TH-CENTURY PICTURESQUE WHARF CELLAR. The wharf cellars in Utrecht were originally built as tunnels linking the Oudegracht quay with the cellars of nearby houses. Later on, they were converted into spaces to store merchandise. De Hoendervorst wharf cellar was recently renovated to form a modern room with kitchenette. The room has its own entrance on the quayside, and you can watch the boats on the Oudegracht while drinking your morning tea or coffee in bed.
